Susan is a Washington, D.C. area artist who has been exhibiting for more than twenty-five years. A long-time GFAA member, she enjoys experimenting with various media and feels comfortable using acrylic as well as watercolor. Her paintings are known for capturing light and mood. Recently she has experimented with layers of paint to reveal lush and complex textured surfaces.

Susan takes great pleasure in teaching. She has made a multitude of friends and many of her students have achieved tremendous personal and professional success. Her goal is to give the beginning students a solid foundation of skills and to give intermediate students a creative challenge and the desire for a personal artistic vision.

Tonight, Susan will demonstrate painting a bird on crescent cold press board which gives a nice texture. She will show examples of paintings on a variety of surfaces which add a new dimension to ho-hum watercolors.

This past year Susan's paintings received awards in shows sponsored by the Southern Watercolor Society, the National Society and Painters in Casein and Acrylic, and Potomac Valley Watercolorists. She was also elected an honorary life member in the Southern Watercolor Society.

Her award-winning paintings can be seen in numerous private and corporate collections including those of Hewlett-Packard, Hughes Network Systems, George Washington University, and the Virginia Dominion Power Company.

In addition to teaching watercolor for the Art League of Alexandria and the Yellow Barn Studio & Gallery in Glen Echo, Susan is a signature member of the National Watercolor Society, Southern Watercolor Society, the Baltimore Watercolor Society, and the Potomac Valley Watercolorists and has received numerous awards in national and regional exhibitions. Her work has been featured in "Splash 5: The Glory of Color" and "The Artistic Touch 4" by Chris Unwin.


We have a great list of speakers lined up for 2016. We are always open for more ideas and lists. Sending best wishes for the New Year and hope to see you often at GFAA events.
